then goes on to ask if she can stay for a week  
to rest up before the demanding month of  
May, long ago dedicated to her. On the  
surface, the week is uneventful; the two  
women talk, shop, cook and exchange  
confidences. Mary tells of miracles  
throughout the ages, and the narrator realizes  
how much she has learned and changed over  
the years, particularly in coming to terms with  
being a single woman. This is a surprising,  
amusing and sometimes profound look at an  
unconventional subject.
